(Kaiden) Barn Etiquette

- Make sure that you are checking the barn duties list everyday and doing your assigned chores. You will be written up if you don't do them!!
- Also everyone should be signed up for a specific feeding time at the barn, both morning and evening. You should only be at the barn during that time slot. If you need extra time at the barn, contact your species sponsor, don't just show up whenever you want. Be sure you are feeding at that time everyday, and if you can't please contact one of the teachers.

- Something new Starting tomorrow you will need to sign into the QR Codes every time you arrive and leave the barn. It will be located next to the chore chart. Updates on this will be given by the species sponsor.
- Make sure you are also giving your animals fresh water twice a day. We want to prevent our animals from getting coccidia when a bird poops in their feed or water. Coccia spreads quickly and can kill your animal. When cleaning your buckets, please only use dish soap and water, please don't use any chemicals or bleach.
- ONLY USE THE TREADMILL WHEN INSTRUCTED. It is very important that you follow the feed and exercise plan your advisor has created for your animal. You can injure yourself or your animal if you do not follow instructions.
